

## **Emergency Rules- Effective June 28, 2017**

### **Parts 1, 25, and 30: Principal Endorsement:**

The four years of experience required for the principal endorsement does not have to be earned on a valid license.

### **Section 25.430: Short Term Approvals:**

**Requirements:** Approvals can be issued if the applicant:

1. Has passed the applicable content test OR
2. Has completed 9 semester hours of coursework

**Validity:** Approvals are valid for 3 full fiscal years.

**Exceptions:** The approval cannot be issued for any special education area or safety and driver's education. The approval can be issued for all other teaching endorsement areas and for any grade range (even grade ranges outside the educator's current grade range.)

**District Verification (Required for Employment Only):** Districts employing an educator on a short term approval must complete a form and file it with their regional office of education, which will upload the form into the educator's ELIS account within 10 business days. This form is not required for issuance of the approval. The form will be similar to the form previously submitted for short-term authorization approvals.
